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Fall Student Expectations:

- Class Participation and Assignments: Students are expected to participate in all class activities, and to be respectful to all other students, faculty, and guest presenters. Socks or bare feet and appropriate clothing are necessary each day.
- **Fieldtrips (Fall and Spring Dates):** AAI theatre students have the wonderful opportunity to attend Dell'Arte and participate in Master of the Arts (MA) level classes 3 times a year. These fieldtrips are an integral part of the exploration into College and Career Readiness. The fieldtrips for this year are tentatively set for the following dates. Please put them on your calendar, but know that they might potentially change. They are each an all day trip.

 - o April 7? (Thursday: Waiting for confirmation)
- **Fall Production:** All students must participate in the fall production, **Arcata's Vaudeville Revue**, either on stage or back-stage.
 - o Required after school rehearsals
 - November 5, 6, 9, 10
 - Times to be determined.
 - **o** Performances
 - **November 12, 13 at 7:30.** Call at 5:30
 - **November 14 at 2:00.** Call at Noon.
- Written Critique of a Production: Students are required to attend one production outside of class each semester and to write a critique about it. The production can be theatrical, dance, circus, or any other type of rehearsed performance. The performance can be a community production, a traveling production, a college production, or another high school's production, but it cannot be a production put on in this class. The rubric for the critique will be handed out soon. The critique is due January 7, with a class discussion.
- **Final Jury:** Students will present their final to a panel of experts within the field. The students will be required to respond to questions about their acting and directing choices. Students need to be prepared not only for the final jury, but also to engage in a dialogue and defend their choices. **Final Jury's will begin January 14.** Please see attached Jury Assignment for specific information.

Grading

- Written Reflections are worth 10% of the final grade and are based on student participation and honest reflections
- **Daily Class Work and Character Work Assignments** are worth **40% of the final grade** and is dependent on student productivity in class, handouts, research, and meeting deadlines for final performances.
- **Final Performances and Rehearsals** are worth **40% of your final grade.** They include, but are not limited to, the fall production, rehearsals for the fall production, the critique, and the final jury. Students will be told what constitutes a final performance in advance.
- Master Class Participation is worth 10% of the final grade.

Class Work and Assignments:

- All work should be completed before class starts on the day it is due. Please be professional with your work and have it completed in a timely manner.
- Extensions are given at the discretion of the teacher. If you need an extension, please email me prior to the due date of the assignment to request an extension.
- Students with excused absences will have one week to make up any missed work. Students with unexcused absences may not make up work unless teacher approval is given. Please email me if you are absent to request a make-up assignment. The assignment will be an alternate assignment based on what content was covered in class.
